with the Wild Ones Fox Valley Area Chapter and Partnering Organizations

Increase your knowledge and skills in botany, ecology, conservation, and uses of native vegetation in Wisconsin! These new classes are taught by highly qualified instructors and held all around the state throughout the year.

You can take the classes individually or earn a certification in Wisconsin native plants by taking 40-hours of classes and completing a 10-hour capstone project of your choice. The classes do not have to be taken in order and there is no time limit to finish the certification requirements.

- 7/30/22 Moths: The Unknown Pollinators (6 hrs - in person, UW Oshkosh)
- 8/13/22 Protecting Our Waters (4 hrs - in person, UW Oshkosh)
- 12/3 & 12/10/22 Wisconsin Forests (5 hrs - in person, UW Oshkosh & High Cliff State Park)
- 2/11/23 Identifying Native Trees and Shrubs in Winter (4 hrs - in person, Mequon)
- 3/4/23 Creating a Native Plant Oasis Design Plan (6 hrs - in person, Mequon)
